According to BC Hockey's rotation of host Districts, the Lower Mainland District is scheduled to host the following BC Hockey Championships during Spring Break, 2011:

- PeeWee Tier 2
- Midget Tier 4

In accordance with BC Hockey Regulation 5, the PCAHA is requesting applications to host these BC Hockey Championships. If your Association is interested in hosting, please submit a letter of request to me by not later than **May 12, 2010**. If multiple bids to host are received, a decision of the District will be made at the PCAHA Annual General Meeting on May 30th.

Other championships may become available if the designated District is unable to host. However, it will likely not be known until the BC Hockey Annual General Meeting in June which other championships are available. BC Hockey normally advertises for hosts for any vacant playoffs.

Please refer to the attached pages for general information about the format and icetime requirements. Actual schedules and championship format will be provided by BC Hockey.

FORMAT:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● If 7 or fewer teams - single round-robin with championship game (1st vs. 2nd): <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ 5 teams - 11 games over 3 days ○ 6 teams - 16 games over 4 days ○ 7 teams - 22 games over 5 days ● If 8 or more teams - teams are split into two round-robin groups (single round-robin in each) with cross-over semi-finals and championship/3rd place games <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ 8 teams - 16 games over 4 days ○ 9 teams - 20 games over 4 days ○ 10 teams - 24 games over 5 days ○ 11 teams - 29 games over 6 days
