Summary - At the conclusion of regular season play, all eligible teams will be ranked on the basis of the final standings, with Tier 1 teams ranked ahead of Tier 2 teams and Tier 2 teams ranked ahead of Tier 3 teams. Teams will be seeded into two playoff groups. The 1st, 4th, 5th, 8th, 9th, 12th, 13th, 16th, 17th, 20th, 21st, 24th, 25th, 28th, and 29th ranked teams will form one group, and the 2nd, 3rd, 6th, 7th, 10th, 11th, 14th, 15th, 18th, 19th, 22nd, 23rd, 26th, and 27th ranked teams will form another group. Teams will be ranked within the seeded groups and will play off according to the formats specified below. The champion of each group will advance to the provincial championships. The playoff group champion with the higher placing at the provincial championships shall be declared the overall PCAHA Champion.

In accordance with BC Hockey Regulations, the BC Hockey Minor Committee allocates "wild card" positions to bring the total number of teams at the provincial championships to six (6). For 2005-2006 the BC Hockey Minor Committee has allocated the Lower Mainland District 1 or 2 "wild card" positions, depending on whether or not North Delta MHA "A1", the Provincial host team, is one of the two playoff group champions.

"Wild Card" Team(s) at Provincial Championships:

The "wild card" team(s) at the provincial championships from the Lower Mainland shall be determined as follows:

- (a) If North Delta MHA "A1" (the Provincial host team) is one of the two Playoff Group champions, then two (2) "wild card" teams shall be as follows:
 - The second place team in the Blue Group Championship Final.
 - The second place team in the Gold Group Championship Final.
- (b) If North Delta MHA "A1" finishes second in the Championship Final in its Playoff Group, then one (1) "wild card" team shall be as follows:
 - The second place team in the Playoff Group not involving North Delta MHA "A1".
- (c) If North Delta MHA "A1" finishes third or lower in its Playoff Group, then one (1) "wild card" team shall be as follows:
 - The winner of a game between the second place team in the Blue Group Championship Final and the second place team in the Gold Group Championship Final. This game shall be played according to the Tiebreaker Game format, Section N(13), at the home of the team winning a coin toss.

Note: In accordance with Section N(3)(e), "wild card" team(s) advancing to the provincial championships are not eligible to be declared PCAHA Champions.
