Summary - At the conclusion of regular season play, all eligible teams will be ranked on the basis of the final standings, with Tier 1 teams ranked ahead of Tier 2 teams, Tier 2 teams ranked ahead of Tier 3 teams, and so on. Teams will be seeded into two playoff groups. The 1st, 4th, 5th, 8th, 9th, 12th, 13th, 16th, 17th, 20th, 21st, 24th, 25th, 28th, and 29th ranked teams will form one group, and the 2nd, 3rd, 6th, 7th, 10th, 11th, 14th, 15th, 18th, 19th, 21st, 23rd, 26th, and 27th ranked teams will form another group. Teams will be ranked within the seeded groups and will play off according to the formats specified below. The champion of each group will advance to the BC Hockey Championships. The playoff group champion with the higher placing at the BC Hockey Championships shall be declared the overall PCAHA Champion.
